What is Emerald Ash Borer - EAB?

Emerald Ash Borer is a serious new pest of Ash trees in the Midwest. It will severely injure and kill all Ash species.

What are the symptoms of Emerald Ash Borer?

- Dieback of leaves beginning in the upper 1/3rd of the canopy and progressing downward over time.
- Vertical splits in the trees bark.
- D shaped exit holes in the bark.
- S shaped channels under the bark
- Numerous water sprouts from the lower trunk.

How do you control Emerald Ash Borer?

Chemical treatment: All Ash should be protected with an annual treatment of soil injected insecticide. The active ingredient is Imidacloprid. We add an 18-3-6 tree formulated liquid fertilizer with micro-nutrients to be sure the tree stays in good health. An Ash with Borer should be treated with a trunk injection for quick control and then with annual treatments to protect against new attacks.
